

The Hall Cemetery originated as the burial ground for Patrick Hall and his descendants and was on Hall land. It is located on/above Flat Run Creek in Clay township, Highland Co., Ohio not far from the junction of Oak Leaf Road and Gray Road. Five generations of Halls are buried there. Eventually other relatives and neighbors were interred between the years 1849 to 1948.

The cemetery is small, old and hidden, with access through a field (off Gray Road); trees have grown up on its fence row. It is falling into disrepair and gravestones have broken as in many old family graveyards.

This is an opportunity to prevent the record of this cemetery and of the people buried there from being lost to posterity.

Some interments without gravestones will remain unknown; a few records are from oral family history, and some are included without documentation.
